- 3. Make sure you have valid ID for you and your entire family.
- 4. Arrive at least an hour before your flight.


Restaurant Upgrade - Coming Soon!





Let's Get Real... Real ID

If you haven't heard, all travelers 18 years of age and older will require a REAL ID or another acceptable form of identification to check in for a flight later this year. A REAL ID-compliant license is marked with a star on the top of the card. If you do not have a complaint license, you will need to go in-person to the DMV to present documentation that verifies who you are in order to get your REAL ID. 
Look to the Sky
